## **Doctor prescribes VYNDAMAX®**



- Your doctor sends your VYNDAMAX prescription to a Specialty Pharmacy
- Specialty Pharmacies are different from local retail pharmacies
  - They usually do not have physical locations, and instead ship specialty drugs to patients' homes

# 2 Confirm insurance coverage



- The Specialty Pharmacy will contact your insurance plan to confirm your coverage for VYNDAMAX®, including co-payment amounts
- The Specialty Pharmacy will review coverage with you by phone and can also discuss financial assistance options
- If you have commercial insurance, you may be eligible to pay as little as \$0 per month through the co-pay savings program\*


# 4 Continuing VYNDAMAX®
